Scale Saloon

MODIFIED CLASS OPEN MOTORS, F1/F2

CLASSIFICATIONS

- Bodies: Saloon or GT/GTO
- Tyres: Only Take Off CSM 22 & 27 Plus Sorex 32 tyres from Schumacher
- Only Pre-Glued tyres for 2006 are permitted, Distributed by CML & Schumacher.
- No self-assembly tyres permitted in 2006.
- Only 2 sets of tyres can be used per day.
- All tyres will be marked after round 1
- Any other set must be pre-scrutineered before they can be fitted, any cars going through scrutineering without any markings on will lose all scores up to round 1.
- Any treaded tyre can be used for wet weather racing and will not be part of the '2 set per day' ruling.
- Only armatures, registered for use in 'Modified Motors' with the BRCA EB can be used – NO HYBRIDS.

This Class will be split into two formulas:-

- F1 for works/B team drivers and anyone who wishes to compete in this class.
- F2 for non-sponsored drivers (this allows drivers with shop discounts).
- All Products must be commercially available in the UK.

N.B. Tyre additives are not banned but if race officials are suspect of any product on tyres they have the right not to handle that car thus failing scrutineering.

19T SPEC CLASS, 27T STD CLASS

CLASSIFICATIONS

- Bodies: Saloon or GT/GTO
- Tyres: Tyres: Only Take Off CSM 22 & 27 Plus Sorex 32 tyres from Schumacher.
- Only Pre-Glued tyres for 2006 are permitted, Distributed by CML & Schumacher.
- No self-assembly tyres permitted in 2006.
- Only 2 sets of tyres can be used per day.
- All tyres will be marked after round 1.
- Any other set must be pre-scrutineered before they can be fitted – any cars going through scrutineering without any markings on will lose all scores up to round 1.
- Any treaded tyre can be used for wet weather racing and will not be part of the 2 set per day ruling.

19T SPEC CLASS ONLY:

- Only those motors on the BRCA EB list can be used.
- The 19T Class is for assisted drivers and anyone wishing to enter apart from F1 Works drivers.

FOR 27T STD CLASS ONLY:

- 27 turn class will be split into 2 classes based on driver ability which will be set after the 1st Meeting by the organisers.
- Any one at the end of the series who gets 93%+ and is within the top 10 in the overall listings will have to move out of the 27T class.
- 27 Turn Stock motor class (openable/re-buildable), as BRCA listings. Bearings can also be fitted in these motors.
- 27 Turn is for non-sponsored drivers
- All Products must be commercially available in the UK.
- No components in either class can be used in other motors apart from those intended to be used in that motor (i.e. no mix & match).
- All Products must be commercially available in the UK.

N.B. Tyres additives are not banned but if race officials are suspect of any product on tyres they have the right not to handle that car thus failing scrutineering.

HEALTH & SAFETY ISSUE:

No installation laps will be permitted at the Start of any Race/Final, all cars must stop in designated pull of area, penalties for disregarding this, start of race withdrawn from that Race/Final, end of Race/Final, lose of score.

Footwear Any person entering the Race Area, must be wearing suitable footwear, to prevent injury to their feet, anyone disregarding this request, enters the area at their own risk.

3 Qualifiers + 2 finals, each final will score it's own points, (see rules break down of how it will work), log onto each clubs web site for details.

ENTRY FEES

(PLEASE READ ARTICLES BELOW)

All entrants this year must be current BRCA Members or a photo copy of the entrants insurance cover must be sent with each entry application. **BE WARNED, without either YOUR ENTRY WILL be returned. Any assistant wishing to enter any Race Area must also have insurance.**

Entry Fees per Meeting will be £8.00. Entrants submitting their entry within the 14 days before each event will have to pay £12. **Remember no pay no play.** No telephone, email or 'on the day' entries will be accepted.

Closing dates are the Tuesday before each event or when full. Only pre-entered entrants will be added into events after this date (entrants on the reserve list).

Refunds will be given to those entrants giving 2 weeks notice to prior meeting.

The organisers reserve the right to, if it is felt that a block booking has taken place and people are cancelling on a regular basis (2 or more cancelations), these person/s will be removed from any remaining TORC meeting **without refund.**

'No shows' will be charged £10 the next time they attend a TORC meeting (subject to the above conditions).
